Each meal that we pack costs FMSC 17 cents. While that doesn't seem like much, it does add up quickly. Monetary donations are welcome from those who wish to contribute. There are also items that can be donated to keep FMSC running smoothly. These include: paper towels, bleach, laundry detergent, liquid hand soap, Dixie cups and hand sanitizer.
