Little Flowers Montessori goes Green: Lunch Ideas

Thank you to those who purchased reusable bags for wet/soiled clothing. It has made a difference already in the amount of plastic bags the Toddler Community goes through on a daily basis.

If you have not purchased any reusable bags yet and would like the resource list again, please let your teacher know and she can get it for you.

When you pack your child's lunch, please be aware of how much your child eats every day. If a lot is coming home, pack less the next day. Most children eat three to four items each day in their lunch.

Another idea to cut down on the amount of waste we generate is to buy in bulk. For example, instead of buying individual containers (yogurt, fruit, dip, etc...), buy a large one and divide it up among small reusable containers for the week.

If your child likes *lunchables*, make your own. It is more nutritious and less wasteful.

Purchase cloth napkins to send in your child's lunch box daily.
